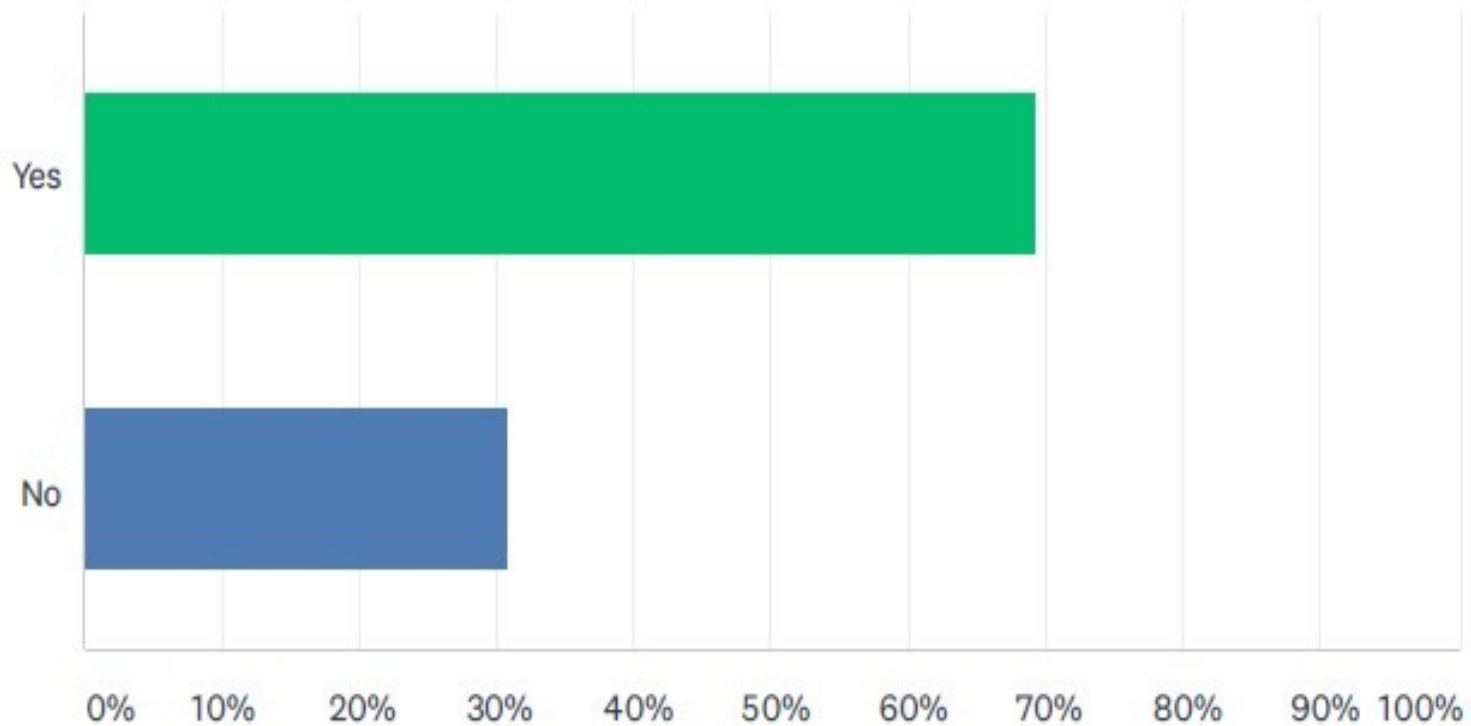


Responses

- 100% Response Rate!

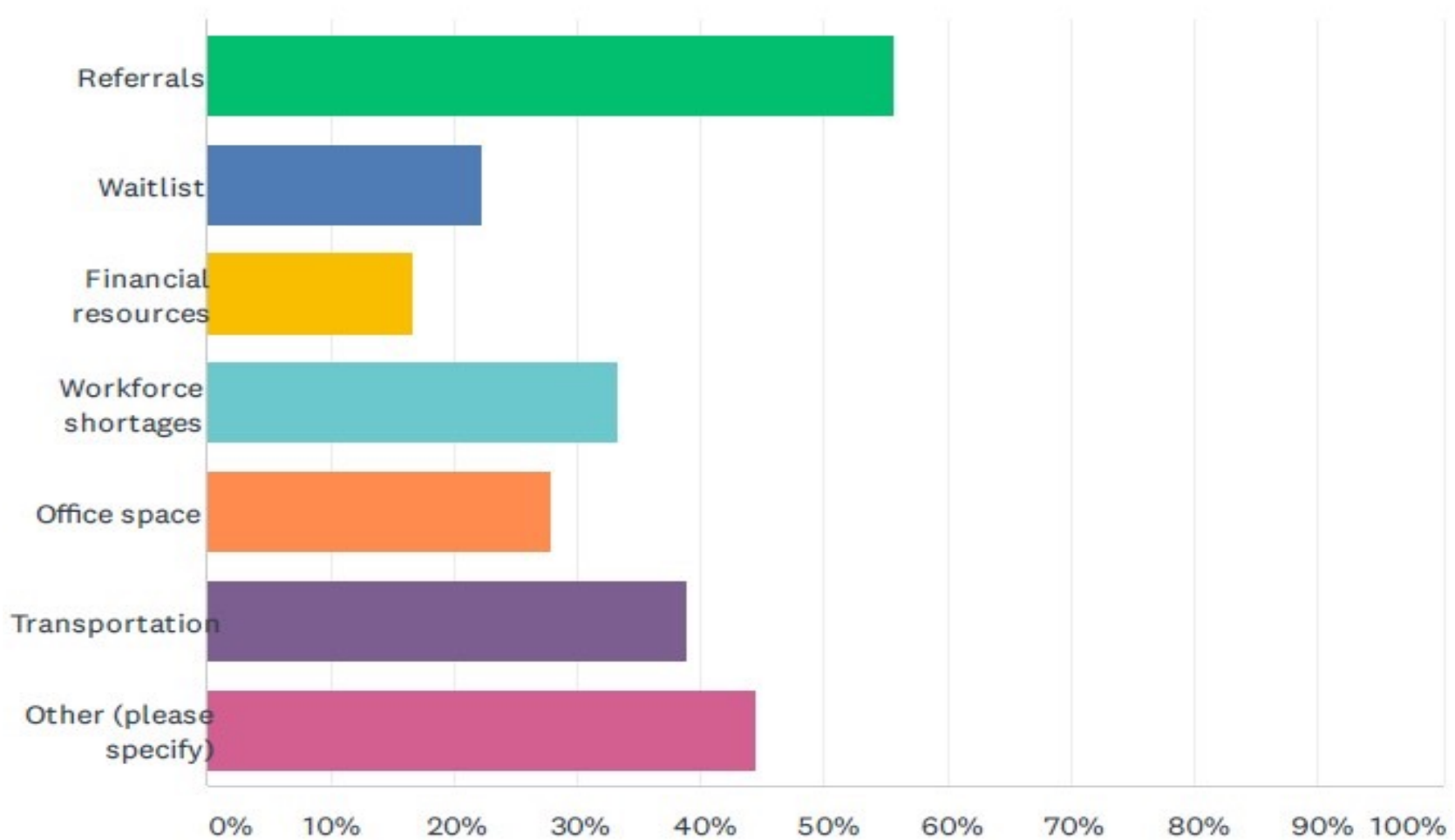


Q. Do you experience barriers to reaching serving Milford's young children and families?

Q. If you had the capacity and resources were available, would you be interested in expanding your services/programs to serve more Milford families and young children?

100% Yes

Q. What would you need?

- 72% Support to expand outreach, referrals, and family engagement
- 32% Increased staff training
- 28% Increased funding for additional staff
- 28% Increased funding to expand services
- 28% Increased office space
- 16% Increased funding for operating expenses



Q. If you had the capacity and resources were available, would you be willing to offer new services/resources (not currently being offered) to Milford young children and families?

80% Yes

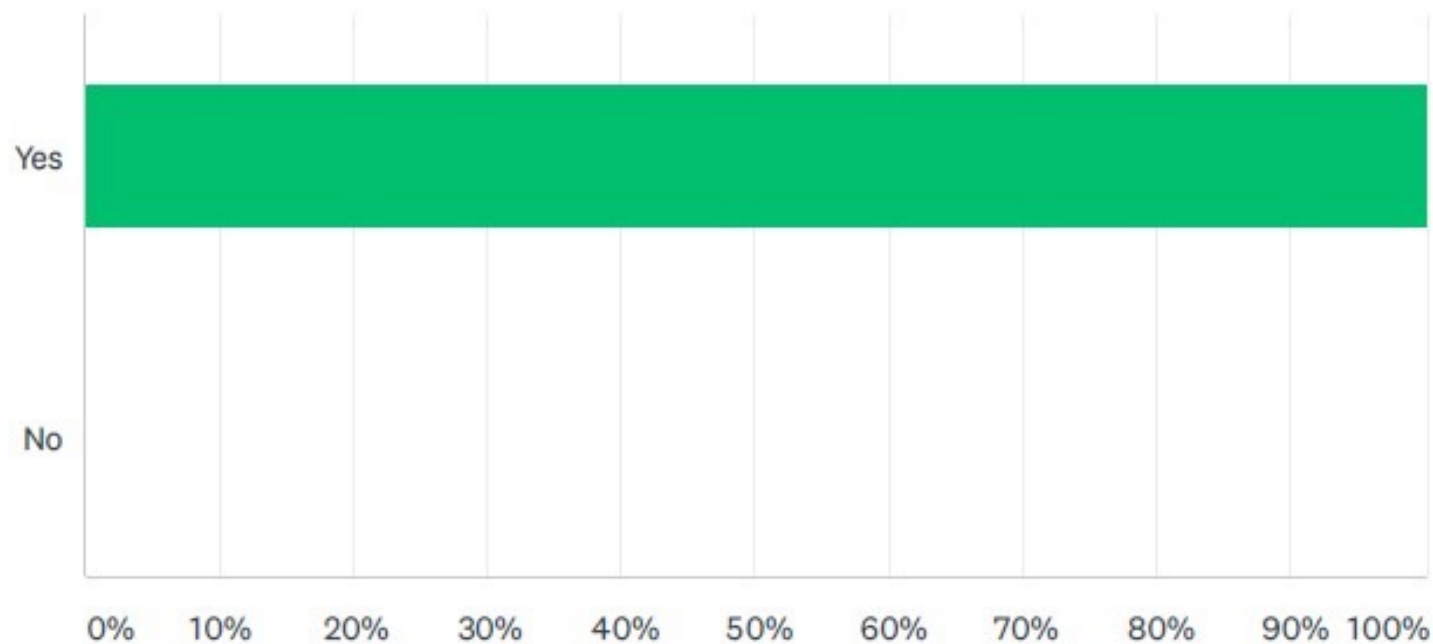
Q. What would you need?

- 80% Support to expand outreach, referrals, and family engagement
- 40% Increased funding for additional staff
- 36% Increased staff training
- 36% Increased funding to expand services
- 24% Increased office space
- 24% Increased funding for operating expenses



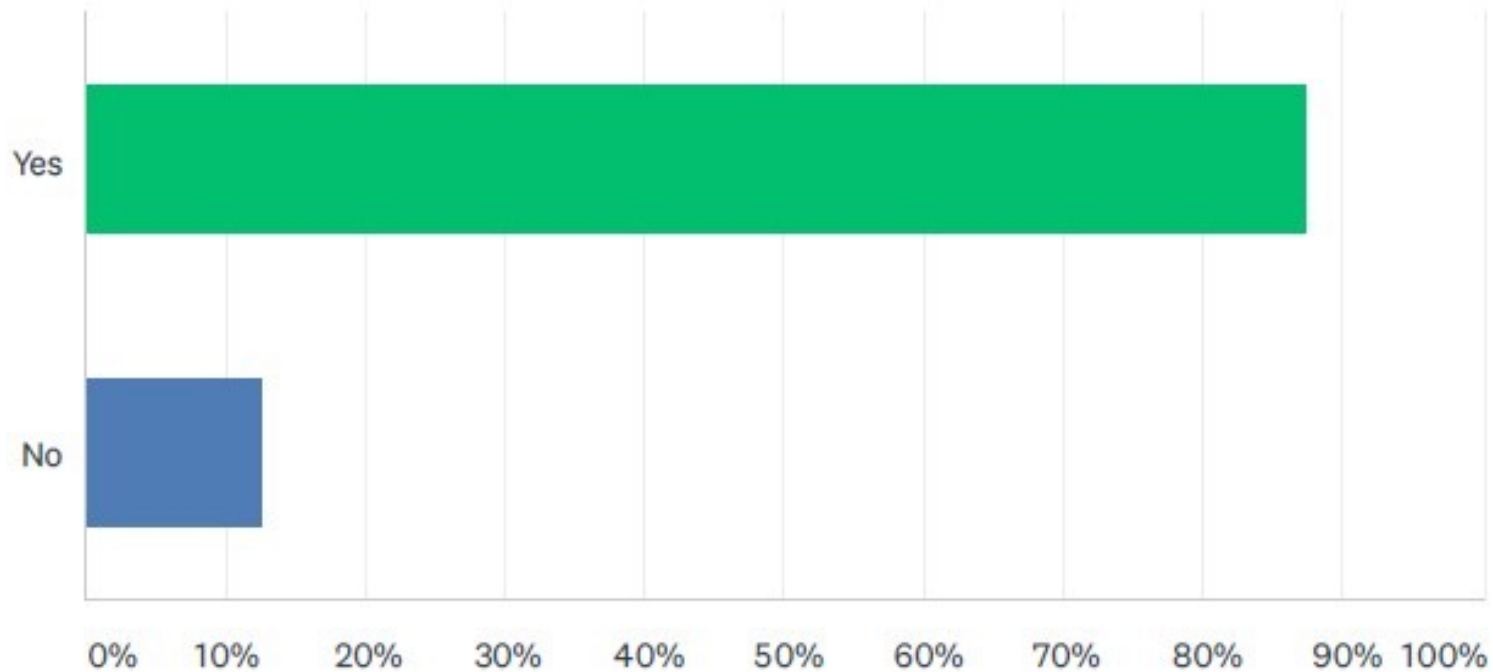

Have you expanded your knowledge of the resources/supports available for area families with young children?

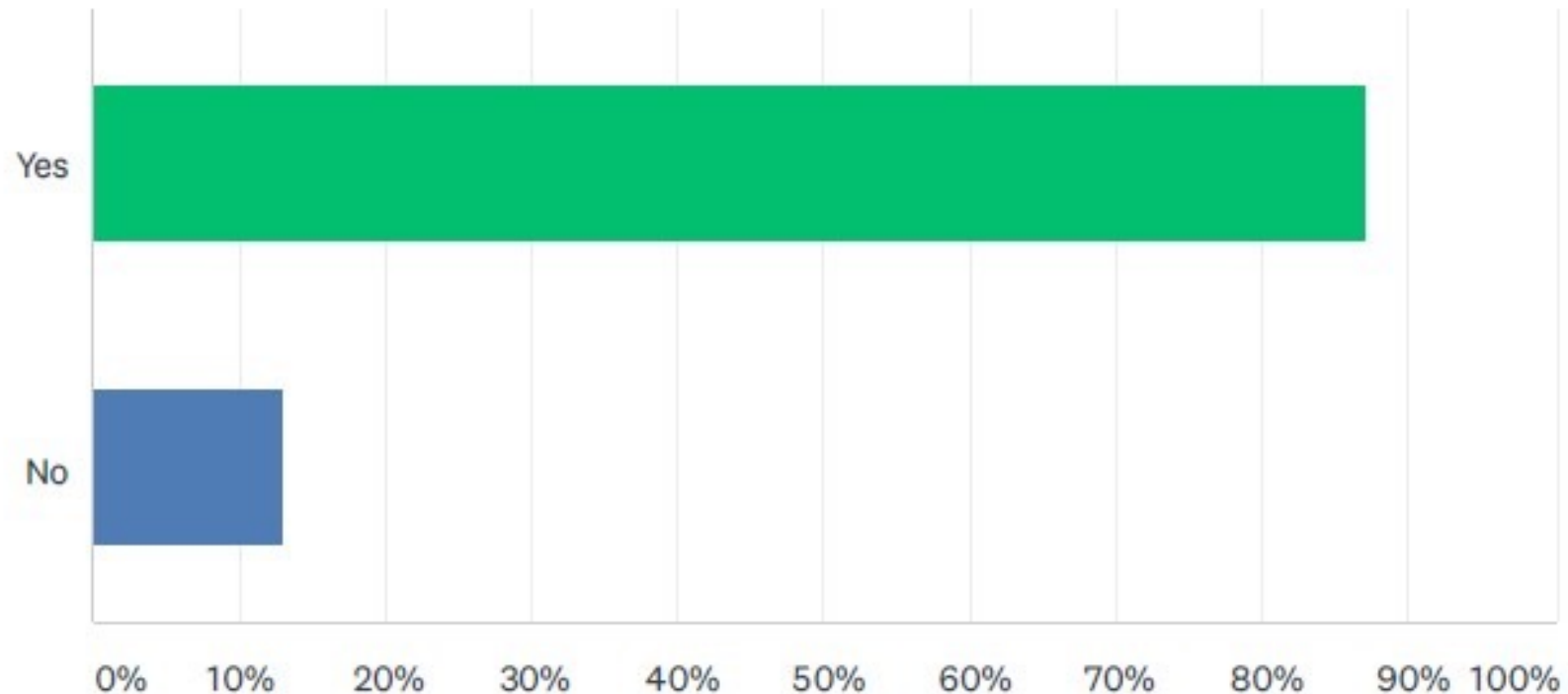
